## **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to these rules.

1. **Eligibility:** All Ponies/Cobs must be registered in the studbook of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. A Pony/Cob must be shown under its full registered Welsh name and number. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the animal's Certificate of Registration. Leased animals being shown must present a copy of registration listing the lessee.

3. **Measurement:** All halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during the current competition year, or be measured. Measurement to occur: by request.

4. **Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless the Tehama District Fairgrounds, Megan Burtness, Gretchen Aitken, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned.

5. **Entries:** Copy of BOTH sides of the registration papers MUST accompany each entry. If you have a current measurement card, include a copy of it. Exhibitor numbers will not be issued until ALL paperwork is in order, and any measuring required has been completed. PLEASE take the time to fill out your entry form correctly and completely.

6. **Driving: For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**

7. **All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear.** Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance.

NOTE: Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.

8. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**

9. **Stake Classes:** To qualify for entry, exhibitors must enter and compete in at least one other class in the division. All stake/jackpot will pay \$20 to first place, \$10 to second place. Classes with less than 3 entries do not pay out Stake money. Any divisions that are not filled (3 entries in all 3 classes) will not be awarded Championships.

10. **Post Entry Rules: Entries are accepted without any post entry penalty. We ask that you please get your entries mailed in as early as you can so that all entries may be entered into the computer system. If you cannot get your entries mailed please e-mail ([megan@bridlewoodwelsh.com](mailto:megan@bridlewoodwelsh.com)) to let us know you are coming. All Entries postmarked by July 20<sup>th</sup> will be eligible to purchase a tack stall at a reduced rate.**

11. **All dogs must be on leash or secured at all times.**

12. Juniors are not allowed to show Stallions.

13. **Payment of Fees:** A completed and signed check must accompany entries. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show, or disciplinary actions will be sought through the WPCSA. Refund Policy: No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate or Doctor's note. The Show Committee's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.

14. **ANY** abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, **WITHOUT REFUND.**

15. Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decisions of the Show Management are final.

16. **Two (2) Minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for requested tack change. The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes.

17. **Wire Wheeled vehicles will be allowed in WPCSA Carriage Driving classes.**

19. **PRIZES:** Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Awards to 1<sup>st</sup> place. Ribbons & awards to Supreme & Division Champions.  
 20. **DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS:** In case of a tie, (except hunter) it shall be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in the hunter division, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number pf points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot and canter using the same judging specifications as in the classes offered in the division. No championship points can be awarded in any division unless all three of the scheduled classes in that division have been held. All three of the WPCSA division classes must have three or more exhibitors showing in each class for championship points to be awarded. Points for championships will be calculated as follows for all performance divisions: 1<sup>st</sup> – 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 2 points, 4<sup>th</sup> – 1 point.

**Measurements will be done Wednesday Afternoon and then throughout the show. Times will be announced at the show .**

**REMEMBER:** You must be a current paid member of WPCSA, WPCAC and SLW&PA for the points to count for these individual associations.

### **WPCSA CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

#### **WPCSA BREED CLASSES (Article 110.2)**

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

#### **WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article 112.3)**

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without a martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

#### **WPCSA WELSH WESTERN PLEASURE (Article 112.4)**

To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring without a martingale, on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint. To be judged on performance, with emphasis on manners 65%; breed type, conformation and movement 25%; appointments 10%. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

#### **WPCSA WELSH HUNTER (Article 112.5)**

Over fences (o/f): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'0", animals exceeding 13.2 shall jump 2'6".

Under saddle (u/s): To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fence class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring, but no more than eight animals at one time.**

#### **WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER (Article 112.6)**

Division is open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. **RIDERS** in this division, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the entire course. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, animal must have shown in **and completed** an over-fences class. Under-saddle class animals will be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. **WPCSA PLEASURE DRIVING (Article 113.1)**

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, **to back readily**. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

#### **WPCSA CARRIAGE DRIVING (Article 113.2)**

**(Wire wheeled vehicles may be used in Carriage Division.)** Classes open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. In addition to the gaits detailed in the pleasure driving section (Article 113.11) (walk, working trot, trot-on, halt and reinback), carriage driving also requires the slow trot where the animal should maintain forward impulsion while showing submission to the bit. Turnout to be judged 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression; 30% on performance, manners and way of going. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire. Obstacle/Cones to be judged 100% on performance.

**WPCSA OBSTACLE - TIME COMPETITION.** Not to exceed 20 obstacles (pairs of cones topped with tennis balls). Faults add seconds to total time. Fastest time wins.

1. To be driven over a prescribed course of obstacles. The number of obstacles to be proportionate to the dimensions of the driving area. Not to exceed 20 obstacles.
2. After passing the starting line, the driver shall proceed through each obstacle in order to the designated finish line.
3. Course faults are scored as penalty seconds and are added to the driver's elapsed time. Placings are determined on a low total time basis. Ties for first will be decided by a drive-off (unless otherwise stated in the prize list).
4. Penalties:
  - a) Exceeding time allowed (every commenced second) 0.5 second

- b) Knocking over start or finish marker 5 seconds
- c) Knocking down or dislodging obstacle 5 seconds
- d) Break in gait, if not allowed
  - 1st break from trot 5 seconds
  - 2nd break from trot 5 seconds
  - 3rd break from trot 5 seconds
  - 4th break from trot Elimination
- Prolonged canter or walk Elimination
- e) Disobedience and/or groom dismounting (cumulative over course)
  - 1st incident 5 seconds
  - 2nd incident 10 seconds
  - 3rd incident Elimination
- f) Starting before signal Elimination
- g) Failure to cross starting line within one minute of signal Elimination
- h) Off course Elimination
- i) Exceeding time limit (2X time allowed) Elimination
- j) Outside assistance Elimination
- k) Failure to carry whip, Elimination
- l) Use of a tie-down or overcheck, Elimination
- m) Breakage of harness or vehicle Elimination

#### **WPCSA Obstacle - Pick Your Route**

1. To be driven over a course of obstacles (paired markers) with no set route. The number of obstacles to be proportionate to the dimensions of the driving area. Not to exceed 20 obstacles.
2. Typically obstacles in this type of class are not measured for each entry, but are set at 2.5 meters or 8'3" at the start of the competition, and only reset in the event of a knockdown.
3. After passing the starting line, the driver shall proceed through each obstacle to the designated finish line, choosing his own route. Each obstacle is to be negotiated once and only once, but may be approached from either direction.
4. Course faults are scored as penalty seconds and are added to the driver's elapsed time. Placings are determined on a low total time basis. Ties for first will be decided by a drive-off (unless otherwise stated in the prize list).
5. Penalties (as they differ from those under penalties section):
  - a) Knocking down or dislodging obstacle 5 seconds
  - b) Driving through an obstacle again 10 seconds each time
  - c) Missing an obstacle Elimination

#### **WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION (Article 114.1)**

Division is open to riders 12 years & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh .

Over Fences (o/f): Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. Animals may either trot or canter the entire course. The o/f class must precede the under saddle class.

Under saddle (u/s): To be judged 100% on hands, seat, control and suitability of mount. **RIDERS** entering these classes may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup Hunter. Animals must walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

#### **WPCSA HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION (Article 114.3)**

Classes open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. To be judged on the rider's appearance, seat, hands and control of their mount.

Over Fence (o/f) classes: to be shown over a minimum of six obstacles.

Under saddle (u/s) classes: to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Test may be required.

#### **WPCSA STOCK SEAT EQUITATION (Article 114.5)**

Classes are open to ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Riders enter the ring at a walk or jog and are judged at a flat-footed four beat walk, two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring. All competitors are required to back a straight line during the line up. Tests may be required.

#### **WPCSA LEADING REIN (Article 115.1)**

Section A, B, C or half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight, years of age. **Ponies to be judged** on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turn-out. This is not an equitation class.

**There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.**

#### **WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2)**

Section A, B, C and half-Welsh, mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but no more than 10, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. **Ponies to be judged** on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class. **There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.**

#### **WPCSA TRAIL (Article 115.3)**

English or Western equipment. Open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance. Juniors not to side pass or lope/canter over loose rails.

**WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)**

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

**WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT (Article 115.4)**

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk and trot/jog. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume and leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot poles.

**WPCSA LEADLINE WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.4)**

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. May be ridden at either a walk or trot/jog. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk and leadline walk-trot .

**WPCSA WALK (Article 115.5)**

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot and walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.

**WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)**

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot poles.

**WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.5)**

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of 4 feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. May be ridden at either a walk or trot/jog. English or Western attire is acceptable. **RIDERS** ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk and walk-trot.

**WPCSA SHOWMANSHIP (Article 115.6)**

Classes should be offered for exhibitors 12 & under and 13-17 years of age. Judged on presentation and showman's ability to show his/her pony/cob/half-Welsh. 40% of the judging is on neatness and appearance of the showman, pony and tack. 60% will be based on the exhibitor's ability to present his/her pony/cob/half-Welsh. Exhibitors will be informed of the judge's choice of pattern to be used before entering the ring.

**WPCSA RIDDEN COB WELSH CLASSIC SEC. C & D (Article 115.7)**

This class is for registered Welsh Cobs and Welsh Ponies of Cob Type 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. Class is an English class only. No Western, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle tack or attire. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter and gallop, on both reins as a group, displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all four gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

**WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSIC SEC. A&B (Article 115.8)**

This class is for registered Welsh Ponies, Section A & B, 4 year of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. Class is an English class only. No Western, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle tack or attire. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter and gallop, on both reins as a group, displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all four gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

**WPCSA BEST RIDDEN AND RESERVE BEST RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Article 115.9) \*\*\*.**

To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on ridden performance. Open to first and second placed winners from the Ridden Welsh A/B Classic and the Ridden Welsh C/D Classic. There is no entry fee for this class. This is an English class only. No Western, Saddleseat or Side Saddle tack or attire. Places will be awarded for the Best Ridden and the Best Ridden Reserve. Any animal in this class is eligible to be named the Best Ridden. Entries shall enter the arena at a walk in a clockwise direction. The Judge shall request all four gaits (walk, trot, canter, gallop) in at least one direction, but animals need not show in both directions. The judge shall consider the size of the ponies/cobs, ages of riders, and safety of arena when determining whether to have the animals perform as a group or individually. Individual pattern is optional at the judge's discretion. Entries shall not be stripped as conformation score from the qualifying class shall be carried forward.

**WPCSA LONG STIRRUP HUNTER (Article 112.7) –Ages 13 to 17 and Adult**

Classes are open to all ponies/cobs and Half-Welsh. **RIDERS** in this division, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division at that show where the fences exceed 18". There are not restrictions for animals exhibiting in these classes. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences and 8 jumping efforts required. Over-fence class must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. May trot or canter the entire course.

**WPCSA LOW HUNTER (Article 112.8)**

Division is open to ponies/cobs and Half Welsh. These **ANIMALS** may not compete in any other over fences division at that show where fence heights exceed 18". There are no restrictions on the rider. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle classes. To be judged 100% on performance. May either trot or canter the entire course. This division is open to juniors and adults.

**Thursday Aug. 5<sup>th</sup>**

Indoor Arena – This ring takes precedence over the trail ring.

5. WPCSA Conformation Hunter \$30 Stake Over Fences A/B – Adult
6. WPCSA Working Hunter Over Fences ½ Welsh – Open
7. WPCSA Conformation Hunter \$30 Stake Over Fences ½ Welsh – Open
8. WPCSA Working Hunter Over Fences C/D – Open
